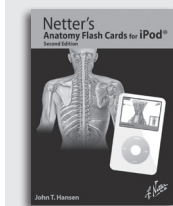

Your AMA membership includes online subscriptions to the *Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA)* and *American Medical News (AMNews)*. Print subscription to *AMNews* and *JAMA* available by request. These subscriptions are not deductible from the annual AMA membership dues. Allow 4-6 weeks to receive your print subscriptions.

Tax deduction information: Medical association dues (except for specific governmental affairs expenses) may be deductible as professional or business expenses, to the extent allowable by law. The AMA Member Welcome Kit will contain information regarding this issue. Dues and other contributions to the AMA are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.

All members receive free online access to *JAMA*, *American Medical News* and the *Archives* specialty journals. Dues paying members are eligible for print copies of *JAMA* and *American Medical News*. The allocated cost of \$32 for *JAMA* and \$29 for *American Medical News* is included in and not deductible from AMA membership dues.

AMA dues are not deductible as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes, but may be partially deducted as a business expense. AMA estimates that 50% of your membership dues are allocable to lobbying activities of the AMA, and therefore are not deductible for income tax purposes.
