ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION AND TARGET AUDIENCE

This meeting is designed for general internists, subspecialty internists, family physicians, fellows in subspecialty training, allied health practitioners, residents, and medical students interested in internal medicine. The purpose is to improve diagnosis and treatment skills and provide updates on new developments in the health care climate in North Carolina.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this educational activity, participants should be able to:

- Understand and appreciate the application of basic science discoveries to the clinical diagnosis and treatment of hematological disorders and the critical care patient presenting in shock.
- Introduce and review standards for increasingly common conditions treated by internists such as organ transplant recipients, organ donors and preparedness for the emergence and pandemic outbreak of H1N1 influenza.
- Improve clinical practice by integrating major new developments in the treatment of common endocrinological disorders, upper respiratory infections, and safe psychiatric medication prescribing.
- Apply updated risk assessment and primary prevention strategies for breast cancer and cardiovascular disease in women.

ACCREDITATION

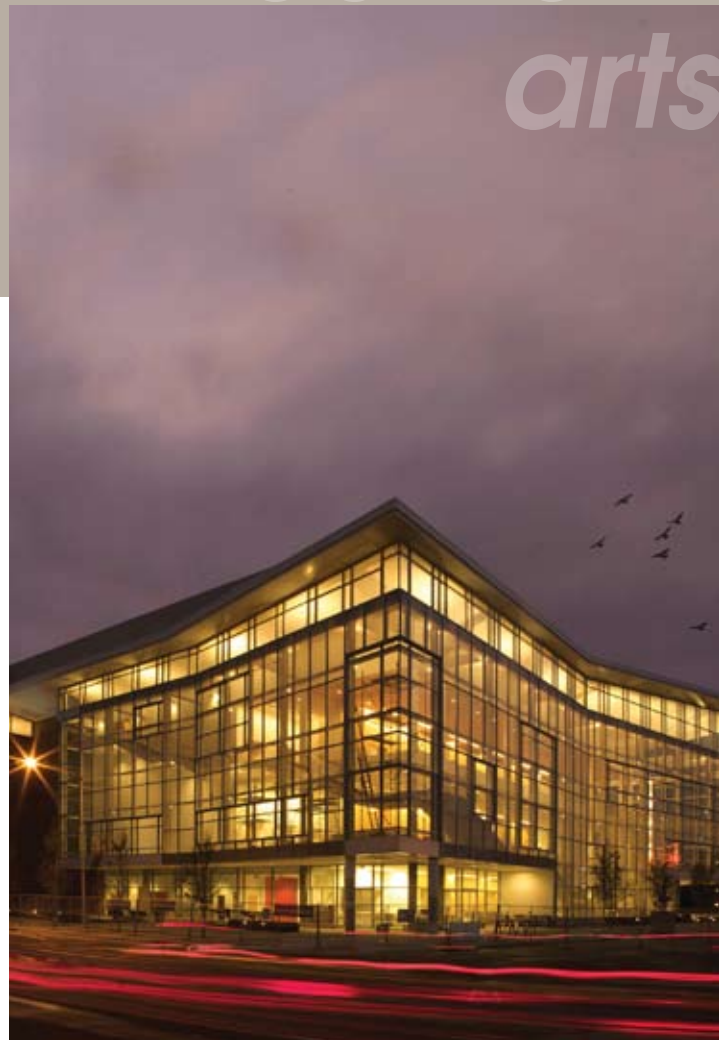
