Dr. Lawrence is the Executive Vice President and CEO of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists. Dr. Lawrence's residency training was at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. Following residency training, he was in private practice with Asheville Ob-Gyn Associates. In 1991, he rejoined the University of North Carolina faculty where he rose to the rank of professor. While working with the medical community in Asheville, the Mountain Area Health Education Center, and the University of North Carolina, an ACGME-approved Ob-Gyn residency training program was established in Asheville in 1992. Dr. Lawrence chaired that department and program until coming to ACOG in the Fall of 2007 to serve as the Vice President for Practice Activities. Dr. Lawrence served as President of the NC Ob-Gyn Society in 1998.



