Most Common Blood Types

Approximate distribution of blood types in the U.S. population are as follows:

O positive - 38%

O negative - 7%

A positive - 34%

A negative - 6%

B positive - 9%

B negative - 2%

AB positive - 3%

AB negative - 1%
