Contributions from corporations are prohibited. Contributions to GOPAC are subject to the limitations of North Carolina Law. Contributions to GOPAC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal or state income tax purposes. NC Law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, profession and field of employment for each individual whose contributions aggregate is in excess of \$50 in an election cycle.
