

NCMS Leadership Position Descriptions

NCMS Board of Directors:

The Board of Directors shall speak and act for The Society, shall be the Board of Censors of The Society and have supreme charge of all questions of ethics and of the discipline of members, shall interpret the Constitution and Bylaws, and shall perform such other duties as are prescribed by law governing directors of corporations or as may be provided in the Bylaws.

- President-Elect
1 year term
 - a. Assist the President in the performance of duties as the President may request.
 - b. Serve as a Vice Chair and voting member of the Board of Directors.
 - c. Serve as a nonvoting member of the Nominating and Leadership Development Committee.
 - d. Preside during the absence of, or upon the request of, the President.
- Region Representative and At-Large Member
3 year term
Shall take the necessary steps to efficiently and effectively identify priorities and views of members. Their role is to represent the Society membership. (Source: NCMS Bylaws)

Alternate Delegate (2 positions open)

The responsibility of an AMA Delegate/Alternate Delegate is to bring the grassroots concerns and opinions of the membership before the AMA House of Delegates, and to report to your actions of the house and the latest scientific, socioeconomic, and ethical information impacting the practice of medicine.

The AMA House of Delegates meet in June and November.

Qualifications to Be a Delegate

- Be an AMA member.
- Elected or selected by the principal governing body or the membership of the sponsoring organization.
- At least 1 member of each delegation is encouraged to be involved in the governance of their sponsoring organization.
