- 3. Tell us about your practice (specialty, group size, etc.). Would you describe your practice setting as a private practice, health system-owned practice, government agency, medical director, or administrative?
- 4. Please describe the experiences and background that drive your interest in this position and that you believe will enable you to serve in this position effectively.
- 5. How long do you expect to remain in active practice?
- 6. Do you have special expertise that may distinguish you from the other candidates seeking this position?
- 7. Are you participating in any value-driven arrangements (such as an ACO, or an alternative payment arrangement) in your practice? How would you describe those arrangements to a layperson?
- 8. Does your practice operate a licensed health facility of any kind (e.g., ambulatory surgery center, birthing center, endoscopy center, medical laboratory)?
- 9. Are you aware of the time requirement for the position you are seeking and are you willing and able to devote the needed time?
- 10. Have you ever been investigated by or had any complaints filed against you with any medical board, hospital board, professional organization, or other medically related oversight body? If yes, please explain.
- 11. Are you aware of any conflicts of interest or other professional/personal matters that would inhibit or limit your ability to dutifully serve the NCMS?
