Time Commitment

Participants will spend ~2 hours per month on collaborative activities. This includes a single, 2-hour virtual learning session and an optional 1-hour coaching session each month. These sessions will be recorded for those than cannot make the live sessions.

Purpose

The presence of an individual with an interest in pediatric emergency care has been shown to significantly improve outcomes for ill and injured children. This collaborative seeks to develop any healthcare professional working—including existing PECCs—in the prehospital or emergency department systems into highly effective champions of pediatric readiness.

Who Should Participate

The collaborative will have four customized tracks: 1) EMS practitioners, 2) nurses/healthcare professionals, 3) physicians/advanced practice providers, and 4) EMSC State Partnership Program Managers.
